❖ Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

We are gathered in God's house. God is the host; we are the guests. As we come together to celebrate the Eucharist, we should feel at home. Since God accepts us, we should accept one another. Let us reflect on the fact that we are not always open to other people, as we should be.

❖ First Reading: (2Kgs. 4:8-11; 14-16)

This tells us about the beautiful act of hospitality, and how God rewarded it. This reading prepares us for what the gospel says about the importance of showing hospitality.

❖ Second Reading: (Rom. 6:3-4; 8-11)

Baptism is a communion with the passion, death and resurrection of Christ. To be baptised means to die to what is sinful in order to live the Christian life.

❖ Gospel: (Matt. 10:37-42)

This is the conclusion of the Mission Sermon given by Jesus to the apostles before He sent them out.
