### ❖ **Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time**

The parable today is an allegory of God's dealing with his people. The landowner is God. The vineyard is Israel. The religious leaders have been given charge of the vineyard but failed to respond to God's invitation.

**First Reading:** (Isaiah 5:1-7)

Israel is compared to a well-cared for vineyard which fails to produce fruit.

**Second Reading:** (Phil. 4:6-9)

St. Paul warns the people of Philippi against anxiety, and advises them as to how they should live in order to enjoy the peace of God.

**Gospel:** (Matthew 21:33-43)

The parable of the wicked vine-dressers tells of God's goodness to his people and of their failure to respond in kind.
