* The Ascension of the Lord

The resurrection, the ascension and the giving of the Spirit are part of the same event. Jesus emerges from the tomb, returns to the Father, and gives the Spirit. The meaning of this feast is expressed in the second reading: God has glorified Jesus, raising him above earthly powers, and making him Head of the Church, and Lord of creation.

❖ *First Reading:* (Acts 1:1-11)

This describes the ascension of Jesus into heaven, and his promise to send the Holy Spirit to his disciples.

❖ Second Reading: (Eph. 1:17-23)

Here Paul describes the meaning of the Ascension: God raised Jesus above earthly powers and made him Head of the Church and Lord of creation.

***** *Gospel:* (Matt. 28: 16-20)

Jesus commissions the apostles to preach the gospel to all nations and promises to remain with them always.
