### ❖ First Sunday of Lent

Temptation is part of our human makeup; a constant struggle for those who want to follow the way of Christ. Today's gospel tells us that Jesus too was tempted. So, He understands our weakness in the face of temptation. To overcome our weakness, we are assured of the help of Jesus.

#### First Reading: (Gen. 9:8-15)

This tells us of the covenant which God established with Noah and his descendants after the Flood.

#### Second Reading: (1 Pet. 3:18-22)

The waters of the Flood of Noah's time were a type of the waters of baptism by which we are saved.

#### Gospel: (Mark 1: 12-15)

After his baptism Jesus spent forty days in the desert during which time He was tempted.

### Reflection - Lent: Springtime in the Spirit
