# Third Sunday of Easter - 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2023

The story of Emmaus is one of the Loveliest Stories in the Gospel. It is a Eucharistic catechesis — a liturgy of the Word is followed by a liturgy of the Eucharist — the breaking of the bread. Jesus joins the two disciples on the road to Emmaus. He explains the Scriptures to them and revealed himself in the breaking of the bread. The same thing happens to us when we gather for the Eucharist. Jesus speaks to us in the Scriptures and nourishes us in Communion.

First Reading: (Acts 2: 14.22-33) On the feast of Pentecost, Peter preaches to the Jews about the resurrection of Jesus.

Second Reading: (1 Peter 1:17-21)
The benefits we enjoy as Christians we won by Christ through the shedding of his blood. Our response should be a life of holiness.

Gospel: (Luke 24: 13-35):

The risen Jesus joins two of his disciples on their journey and shows them that it was by dying that he entered into glory.

Reflection: All of us have some experience of the road to Emmaus.

That road represents the road of disappointments, failure, sorrow and broken dream. But the risen Lord journeys with us

His resurrection opens all our stories to the prospect, not just of a good ending, but of a glorious ending.

Stay with us Lord, and let your presence inflame our

hearts, and raise our spirits, so that we may journey towards your kingdom with undimmed hope.
