### TWELFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - 25<sup>th</sup> JUNE 2023

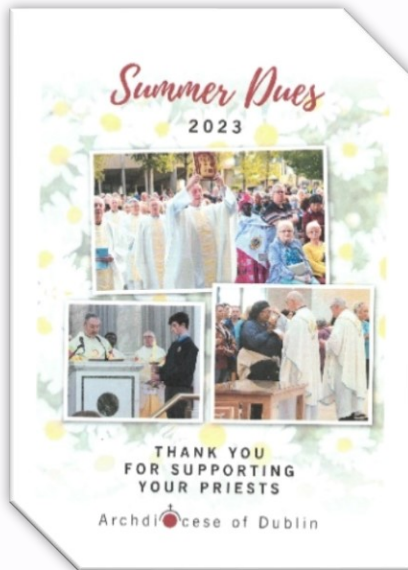
