Parable of the Lamps

Every Christian is meant to be a bearer of the light of Christ to a darkened world. But sometimes, through lack of prayer, we allow that light to go dim.

**First Reading**: (Wis. 6:12-16): Our reading sings the praise of wisdom and says it can be found for those who seek it diligently. The consequences of not seeking this wisdom can be seen in the life of the foolish maidens.

**Second Reading**: (1Thess. 4:13-18): St. Paul consoles his converts at Thessalonika who are worried about the fate of their loved ones who have died.

<u>Gospel: (Matt. 25:1-13)</u>: This reading deals with what happens at the end of time. The parable of the ten virgins stresses the need for watchfulness.
