Gospel: (Mark 1:12-15): Jesus is in the wilderness of the desert in the Gospel and he emerges from this experience proclaiming Good news from God. The early Christians realised that the flood of God's grace, which flows from Jesus' desert experience, is positive because it is about our Baptism.
