CHANGE OF MASS TIMES

I'd like to thank you for your understanding about our exploring the necessity of reducing, by one, the number of Sunday Masses we have here in Laurel Lodge. Over the past two months we've been able to accommodate the numbers of people attending on Sunday mornings in two celebrations. After consultation and dialogue with our partnership parishes, and with a view to providing a variety of Mass times, it has been decided that from the beginning of September our Sunday morning Masses in St. Thomas the Apostle will be at 9.30 and 11.30. This allows priests covering our entire partnership time to travel between the churches. It also allows time for unrushed, fuller celebrations. I know this may impact your Sunday morning routine. Thank you again for your patience.

In many other parishes, people have been asked if they would be so gracious as to share a Mass intention with another family seeking to remember a loved one, particularly in the case of Saturday Vigil and Sunday Masses, and this has worked well. So, it is my hope that this solution will be acceptable to you and your families.
