World Day for Consecrated Life

The feast of the Presentation is a remembrance of the Lord and Mary. The symbol of the lighted candle is used to proclaim Jesus as the light of the world. Christ is the light to reveal God to the nations.

<u>First Reading</u>: (Mal.3:1-4) The Lord will send his messenger whose presence will be a source of purification and refinement to his people.
<u>Second Reading</u>: (Heb.2:14-18) Jesus shared the same blood as the human being. He became like his brothers so that he should be as compassionate and trustworthy as the high priest.


