This is the feast of Corpus Christi, the Body of Christ.

We are gathered to celebrate the Eucharist becoming visible.

First Reading: (Deut. 8:2-3.14-16): The author exhorts the people to remember that they are God's people who need to nourish themselves on God's Word.

Second Reading: (1Cor.10:16-17): In the Eucharist we all share the same bread. However many there are we form the one body of Christ. **Gospel:** (Jn. 6:51-58):

As food and drink nourish the body, so Christ nourishes for this life and eternal.

REFLECTION
